overview

Camp is an exciting place for girls to enjoy a well-rounded Girl Scout experience. Girls will learn new things and grow strong in any session they choose to attend. Day camp allows girls a safe environment to learn new games, make arts and crafts, practice outdoor cooking skills, develop environmental awareness, and, most of all, have fun with new friends and play in the water. Day camp is the perfect starter camp for girls who want to get comfortable in the outdoors and who are interested in exploring new activities close to home. **Before and after care is available at all day camps at no additional charge, with the exception of the three community day camps listed on page 16.** For the day camps listed on pages 13-15, lunch and snack are included each day. For the community day camps listed on page 16, snacks are included but campers should bring a sack lunch.

Typical Day Camp Schedule

- 7:30-9:00 a.m. *Check-in and before care*
- 9:00 a.m. *Opening flag ceremony and morning snack*
- 9:30-11:30 a.m. *Girl-planned activities focused on education and weekly theme (art instruction, cooking lessons, ecology games, etc.)*
- 12:00-1:00 p.m. *Lunch and rest time*
- 1:00- 3:30 p.m. *Girl-planned activities focused on practicing new skills (water activities, scavenger hunts, games, etc.)*
- 3:30 p.m. *Closing flag ceremony and afternoon snack*
- 4:00-5:30 p.m. *Check-out and after care*

Friday campers participate in all-camp activities, showing off their new skills and trying to complete the weekly challenge!
