	<p>Girls in grades 1, 2, and 3 are eligible to participate in the <i>God and Me</i> program. Each participant must have her own copy of the Student Workbook. A pastor's signature is required on the application /order form.</p>	<p>The <i>God and Me</i> curriculum is designed to help children become best friends with Jesus and tell their story of "God and Me" together.</p>
	<p>Girls in grades 4 and 5 are eligible to participate in the <i>God and Family</i> program. Each participant must have her own copy of the Student Workbook. A pastor's signature is required on the application/order form.</p>	<p>The <i>God and Family</i> curriculum is designed to help youth understand the importance of family and God's role in a healthy family.</p>
	<p>Girls in grades 6, 7 and 8 are eligible to participate in the <i>God and Church</i> program. This program requires that students have original workbooks and present their work to the pastor for final approval.</p>	<p>The <i>God and Church</i> program will lead young people on a journey. It will be a faith journey with three parts: meeting Jesus, worshipping God, and witnessing and ministering for Christ.</p>
	<p>Young women in grades 9 – 12 are eligible to participate in the <i>God and Life</i> program. Each participant must have her own copy of the Student Workbook. A pastor's signature is required on the application/order form.</p>	<p>The <i>God and Life</i> program is the fourth program in the God and Country Series. It is a reflective type of curriculum: students will study the lives of men and women in the Bible and discover what their lives teach them about God. The young people will then be challenged to integrate their faith into their daily lives</p>

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
